- No entry to the show field for camping until 12pm on Thursday 10th September.
- There will be no vehicle movement between the hours the show is open, 10am - 4pm. If you need to leave the showground for any reason, please speak to an onsite marshal, or pay gate member who will get you escorted out the show field.
- All traders must have valid and appropriate insurance for their services, please bring a enclose a copy of your insurance with this trade form.
- All services are required to be orderly and tidy and responsible for disposing of their own waste / rubbish. Waste bins & Elsan points are located on site as well as toilets & mains water.
- Caravans & tents must be pitched not less than 10' from each other on site in adherence to the fire regulations.
- There is a maximum speed of 5 MPH for all moving vehicles on the show field.
- Dogs must be keep on a lead at all times when on the show field and in the public car park.
- Marshals have the authority to re-site those not meeting this requirement. Instructions from officials and security must be adhered to for personal and site safety
- All exhibitors must obey the Marshal's instructions when on site.
- All trade stands, displays, must be covered by publicity liability insurance.
- This event is run solely by volunteers and we will not tolerate any aggressive or negative behaviour towards the marshal's or persons on site, anyone doing so will be escorted off site.
- Catering services and stalls are welcome to trade for exhibitors on site Friday as well as all weekend.
- The organisers accept no liability for any of the exhibitors property or personal effects or any personal and public injury or liability during the event.
- Should there be any circumstances beyond our control, resulting in the cancellation of the event, we are unable to offer refunds.
