Bournemouth & Poole Preservation Club was formed in November 1979 and was set up to promote preservation and to support those in the area who were interested in preserving or collecting. Our membership is not restricted to people living in Bournemouth or Poole.

We meet on the second Thursday of every month at Hamworthy Club, Magna Road, Canford Magna, from 7.30p.m in the Skittles room. We may have a quiz, an auction night, play skittles, a slide show, guest speaker or just sit and talk amongst friends.

Throughout the year we host several events such as our **Spring Memorial Run, Club BBQ and Cobweb Run**, as well as attending other events with a club stand, which members can join in with any exhibit. In September we host our main event **Classic & Steam Vehicle Show**, in Harman's Cross Swanage. This event is open to all exhibits and raises money for Swanage Railway, in 2019 we donated £3600 to them from this event.

Paid up club members are covered by third party liability insurance up to £5 million per claim (traders are not covered), details will be on your membership card.

As a member you will receive bi-monthly newsletters, containing various articles and news of local events. Membership is annual at £17 per couple, for a posted magazine or £14 per couple, for an emailed magazine. Magazines can also be collected on club nights.
