- No entry to the show field for camping until 12pm on Thursday 8th September.
- There will be no vehicle movement between the hours the show is open, 10am - 4pm. If you need to leave the showground for any reason, please speak to an onsite marshal, or pay gate member who will get you escorted out the show field.
- There is a maximum speed of 5 MPH for all moving vehicles on the show field.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times when on the show field and in the public car park.
- All exhibitors must obey Marshal's instructions when on site.
- As the showground is uneven, we ask that you bring your own wheel chock and leave your vehicle in gear, where appropriate, to secure your vehicle.
- All exhibitors must have valid and appropriate insurance for their exhibit, please bring a copy with you to the show, as we may ask you to produce it during the event.
- The organisers accept no liability for any of the exhibitors property or personal effects or any personal and public injury or any liability during the event.
- All trade stands, displays, must be covered by publicity liability insurance.
- No exhibit, No Pass.
- This event is run solely by volunteers and we will not tolerate any aggressive or negative behaviour towards the marshal's or persons on site, anyone doing so will be escorted off site.
- Exhibits must be at least 20 years old to exhibit at this event.
- All working exhibits must be in a safe working condition.
- Should there be any circumstances beyond our control, resulting in the cancellation of the event, we are unable to offer refunds.
- The £15 Exhibit fee entitles 2 adults to travel unlimited on the Swanage Railway during Friday, Saturday and Sunday, evening trains will also be running, timetables will be available closer to the event.
- Money raised at this event goes to Swanage Railway, in 2019 we donated £3600 to them from this event.
- We do not offer refunds if you are unable to attend.
